Haunted Colorado



Colorado's haunted history is deeply tied to its past as a frontier state. The intense emotions of the Gold Rush, the tragedies of mining accidents, the hardships of the Wild West, and the many abandoned ghost towns scattered across the state contribute to a culture steeped in legend and mystery. Whether you're a skeptic or a believer, the stories of haunted Colorado continue to captivate, drawing in ghost hunters and thrill-seekers from around the world. Here's a look at some of the most haunted locations in the state:

The Stanley Hotel (Estes Park)

One of Colorado's most famous haunted spots, the Stanley Hotel, inspired Stephen King's The Shining. Guests and staff

have reported strange occurrences since the hotel opened in 1909. Phantom footsteps, flickering lights, and ghostly apparitions are

common tales. The most haunted area is Room 217, where guests have experienced everything from objects moving on their own to the sensation of being watched.


Cheesman Park (Denver)

Cheesman Park in Denver has a dark history. It was once a cemetery, but in the late 1800s, the city decided to convert it into a park. However, many of the bodies were never



properly moved, and visitors today report feeling uneasy, with some claiming to see ghostly figures

at dusk. The park's haunted reputation stems from its unsettling past, with many graves still lying beneath its grounds.



The Molly Brown House (Denver)

The Titanic survivor Margaret "Molly" Brown's house in Denver is said to be haunted by both her spirit and that of



her husband, J.J. Brown. Visitors report hearing mysterious voices, footsteps, and even the piano

playing by itself. Staff have also described objects moving or disappearing. The house is now a museum, and while it celebrates Molly's life, it also embraces its haunted reputation.



Central City, known for its mining history, is home to the haunted Masonic Cemetery. One of the most famous ghosts




is that of a woman dressed in black who is said to visit the grave of John Edward Cameron every year

on April 5th. No one knows who she is, but locals have reported seeing her vanish into thin air. The cemetery, perched on a hill, offers a quiet yet eerie setting that has

spooked visitors for generations.



Aspen's luxurious Hotel Jerome has been around since 1889 and is said to host several ghostly entities. The most famous is the spirit of a little boy who allegedly drowned in the hotel's pool in the early 1900s. Guests have reported seeing the boy wandering the halls in a drenched suit or hearing his





laughter in the middle of the night. The hotel's opulent setting only adds to the ghostly allure.



The Gold Camp Road Tunnels (Colorado Springs)

Just outside Colorado Springs, the Gold Camp Road tunnels have a sinister reputation. The tunnels were built in the late

1800s to serve as train routes for the mining industry, but several workers are said to have died

during their construction. Today, visitors report hearing screams, feeling cold spots, and seeing strange shadows when driving through. One tunnel is even rumored to have collapsed on a school bus in the 1980s, adding to the eerie atmosphere.



The Museum of Colorado Prisons (Cañon City)

Formerly a women's prison, the Museum of Colorado Prisons is known for paranormal activity. Visitors have

reported hearing disembodied voices, seeing shadowy figures, and experiencing cold spots throughout

the building. The prison's dark history, combined with the tragic fates of many of its inmates, has led to its haunted reputation.





The Brown Palace Hotel (Denver)

Opened in 1892, the Brown Palace Hotel in Denver has hosted celebrities and dignitaries, but it's also home to

several ghosts. One of the most well-known hauntings is that of a man in a train conductor's uniform

seen wandering the halls. Guests have also reported hearing children laughing and the unexplained sounds of a piano playing in the ballroom, long after everyone has gone to bed.






Riverdale Road (Thornton)

Perhaps the most famous haunted road in Colorado, Riverdale Road, stretches between Thornton and Brighton. It's often called "The Gates of Hell" due to the numerous

paranormal reports tied to it. The road is believed to be cursed, with stories ranging

from ghostly apparitions to strange sounds and even demonic entities. One of the most

chilling legends is that of a phantom jogger. According to the story, a jogger was hit by a car along the road, and now his spirit haunts the area, often chasing after cars that speed by. Drivers have reported hearing rapid footsteps and banging on their car doors, only to look and find no one there. Riverdale



Road is also said to be home to a ruined mansion where a man reportedly went mad and burned his house down with his family inside, leaving behind restless spirits that still wander the area.

Phantom Canyon Road (Between Florence and Victor)

A scenic yet isolated dirt road winding through the mountains, Phantom Canyon Road is part of the Gold Belt Scenic Byway. Its name alone evokes an eerie feeling, but the road's haunted reputation comes from its history as a former stagecoach route and railway line. The area was a hotspot during Colorado's gold rush, and many workers died during its construction.



Travelers have reported seeing ghostly apparitions of miners along the sides of the road, especially near old mining sites. Some claim to have encountered an eerie stagecoach, pulled by spectral horses, disappearing into the mist. The road itself, with its sharp turns and narrow pathways, can feel unnerving, especially at night when the mountains close in, and shadows play tricks on the eyes.

Third Bridge (Between Aurora and Bennett)

Third Bridge, also known as "Ghost Bridge," is located east of Aurora and has been the center of numerous ghost sightings and paranormal reports. The bridge crosses Kiowa Creek and is surrounded by rural farmland, creating an isolated and eerie atmosphere. Many visitors have reported hearing ghostly drumming, believed to be the echoes of Native American



ceremonies or battles that took place in the area long ago. Visitors to Third Bridge frequently mention strange sounds, sudden drops in temperature, and an overwhelming sense of dread, particularly at night.
